Superintendent Reyes reported that PBIS Silver Recognition was awarded to Bell Avenue, Glenwood and Robla schools and Bronze Recognition to Main Avenue School. Also, Back To School Nights are taking place tonight at all of our schools. He explained that the district is making its Kindergarten To College (K2C) program this year universal, meaning ALL students will receive funds. Finally, he said that former district superintendent, Charles Pryor stopped by our Employee Welcome Back Picnic last month.

He reviewed historical and projected ADA; recapped general fund balance activity; compared budgeted to actual revenues, expenses and changes in fund balance; summarized district fund balances; showed a pie chart of general fund revenues and expenditures; outlined through 2021 the effects of increased STRS and PERS contributions; shared other considerations moving forward from 2017-2018; and updated the board on
