

Regular Meeting Minutes Robla School District Governing Board May 25, 2017 at 5:30 P.M.

Call to Order

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 5:37 p.m. Present: Kim Howard (Presiding), Nuvia Cardona and Craig DeLuz. Absent: Dennis Boyd and Ken Barnes. Also present: Superintendent Ruben Reyes. Trustee Howard led the Pledge of Allegiance. It was moved/seconded (DeLuz/Cardona) to adopt the agenda with an addendum. Motion carried. Trustee Howard acknowledged that any written communications to the Board had been distributed. There was no public comment.

Presentation: Facilities Update

Emilio Flores, CEO of Caldwell Flores Winters, reported that CFW is working with Clark & Sullivan to establish Guaranteed Maximum Price for Main Avenue as well as interim housing plan for Taylor Street School. Also, CFW is working on closeout of project at Main Avenue. This will prevent DSA or CDE delaying approval of new projects and access to state aid. At the end of construction at Main Avenue and Taylor Street, some portables may be retained as interim housing for students.

Presentation: Dual Language Immersion Program Superintendent Reyes reviewed the presentation given to the DLI Program Parent Orientation Meeting. He introduced consultant Julie Hoskins, who reviewed the program design document which will be updated as the program progresses.

Presentation: Technology

Adam VeVea showed his current staff, shared what is new for this year, reported no major issues with CAASPP testing, announced what is coming soon to the district and opened the floor for questions.

Presentation: State Budget

Mike Henkel shared recent state budget information, reviewing key points of changes from the January budget, and concluded with how the future looks.

Discussion: Immigration Rights Information (Addendum item) Superintendent Reyes shared the flyer "Know Your Rights" prepared by the ACLU that outlines rights if you are stopped by law enforcement or immigration. He said the flyer has been vetted through our attorney. The board gave approval to distribute to families after the superintendent contacted absent board members to obtain their approval.
