Call to Order

Program

Mike Henkel, CBO, highlighted events occurring during 2017-2018 and discussed the department's financial health. Erica Lee, Coordinator of Student Health and Wellness reviewed the culinary training our staff received to help maximize kitchen efficiency. Cathy Green, Director of Food and Nutrition Services, discussed what's new for 2018-2019, discussed the School Breakfast Promotion and shared the new menu items. Erica Lee highlighted the new district wellness policy, showed a birthday basket, and outlined student wellness activities – Kids Farmers Market, Choose My Plate classroom activities, California Thursdays and field trips to Fiery Ginger Farms. She shared ideas on the horizon - wellness in the schools, fresh fruit and vegetable program and TV monitors displaying the menu item and other nutrition information.

Freedom School



Derrell Roberts, Co-Founder of RFDC, apologized for the absence of Michelle Crisp, Freedom School teacher, due to illness. He shared that Freedom School is a city wide endeavor, gave a brief history of the program. Next, Elliot Davis, Program Director, outlined the daily schedule and activities of Freedom School, such as Harambee and Integrated Reading Curriculum. She further discussed field trips and afternoon curriculum. Mr. Roberts explained how they involve parents in Freedom School by offering workshops and parent meetings. He discussed extended day services and the training provided to servant leader interns. He hopes to host a Spanish speaking class next year. Joelle Toney, Freedom Schools teacher, related how the theme "I can make a difference in myself, my family, my community, my nation, my world" had a positive effect on one of her students.

Transportation

Patty Brown, Director of Transportation and Mike Henkel, CBO, shared a breakdown of the department, outlined 2018-2018 department highlights, provided ridership numbers, explained the daily routes and route planning, discussed fleet and age of fleet, reviewed budget and concluded by listing steps taken to ensure student and staff safety.

Hazel Health

Jeannie Chen of Hazel Health, played a video about the program in our district. She explained ESSA, shared facts about the effects of chronic absenteeism, compared Robla's chronic absence rates with the state, listed absence rates by school, shared facts about the Robla community, and discussed consent to treatment by absenteeism segment, monthly visits by schools and encounters by visit type. Judy Allen, District Nurse, said she enjoys being part of the Hazel Health team. She shared some success stories. Josh Golomb compared 2016-17 and 2017-18 monthly absence rates, demonstrated that students who visit Hazel are showing reduced absenteeism, particularly those with chronic absenteeism, and showed that 9 out of 10 students who visit Hazel return to school. He concluded by sharing feedback reflecting positive initiator experience with Hazel and the convenient access for parents.




